Curiousity Cruise & Gin Tour

Saturday 19th August, 2023

Sunday the 19th started a little cloudy, but not cold, so I decided to take the mighty Sunbird on the drive. Dropping Jeanette off in the city for a surprise belated birthday present, I proceeded to the Redwood Tavern carpark with our grandson Ben, and his girlfriend Brooke, to meet up with our other members and guests keen on the cruise and distillery tour.

When all cars had arrived, a very brief drivers briefing took place and everyone was in their car and ready to go right on 11.30, just as the rain began to fall.

As I had to collect Jeanette from the city, I did not join in the cruise, but we all met up at The Spirits Workshop Distillery, home of Curiosity Gin, and Divergence Whisky.

Once we have all managed to get ourselves seated in the compact tasting area, we are treated to a very informative talk on the making of different blends of gin, some being very unique and novel, like mint chocolate, as well as the long-awaited tasting. The range of gins were quite diverse with very different tastes from each bottle. The blends use as many local ingredients as possible, with only the Juniper berries being imported, as NZ currently does not grow them in commercial quantities.



The two whisky flavours were also very different, but also good.

The tour through the brewing rooms was a bit of an eye opener as it really is a boutique distillery in size, but capable of turning out up to 400 bottles of gin a week, both for themselves and other companies.

The whisky is normally left to mature in oak barrels in the barrel room for 4 & a half years before being bottled. The barrel room also contains smaller casks belonging to customers that have distilled their own whisky blend.

All the bottles have their labels placed on them by hand, and the whisky cork and bottle top is also hand sealed with a special wax imported from England.

If you enjoy a quality gin or whisky, then The Spirits Workshop Distillery is definitely worth a visit to purchase direct from the store.

Another enjoyable event organised by our committee. Once again, thank you, and well done!
