Heathers Scone Mix

Heather Harris not so secret Scone recipe



- 4 Cups of Flour
- 4 tsp of Baking Powder
- 2 tbs of Caster Sugar
- 1/4 tsp of Salt
- 100gm of Melted Butter
- 1 1/2 Cups of Milk approx.
- 1. Heat oven to 210 degrees celsuis
- 2. Put "drys" in a bowl and mix with whisk to combine.
- 3. Make a well
- 4. Melt Butter 40 seconds in Microwave and add to milk
- 5. Pour into the well
- 6. Mix from the centre of the well to combine
- 7. Mix together (use a knife)
- 8. Flour Board well as mix is wet and sticky
- 9. Place mix on board, flour top of mix and hands,
- 10. Knead for 5 minutes or soft.
- 11. Pat to a 3 centimetre high rectangle and cut into shapes you want.
- 12. Put on trays and rest for 20 minutes
- 13. Brush top of scones with milk and place in hot oven for 10-15 minutes or until golden.

For -

Date Scones - Add 1 1/2 cups of chopped dates into Flour mix

Cheese and Herb

- Add 1 1/2 cups of Tasty grated cheese and 1 teaspoon of mixed herbs and a pnch of cane pepper.


