
The Old Leithfield Hotel in Leithfield, New Zealand was built in 1855 by John Leith.

It was a stopover for travelers and a focal point for the local community.

History

- The hotel was made of mud block and had a thatched roof.
- It included stables and an accommodation building.
- It was a stopover for travelers including the Cobb and Co coaches and passengers.
- The hotel burned down in 1911.
- A pub was built on the site in 1912.
- The pub was a landmark for travelers returning from a day in the big city.


